



ALLUVIAL LICENCE RENEWED AT LULO DIAMOND PROJECT

Lucapa Diamond Company Ltd (ASX: LOM) is pleased to announce that the licence covering alluvial diamond exploration at the 3,000km² Lulo Diamond Concession in Angola has been renewed for a further two years until December 2014.

Lucapa expects to lodge an application later this month to renew the kimberlite exploration licence at Lulo for a further two years until June 2015.

Lulo is operated as a joint venture between Lucapa and the Government-owned diamond company Endiama, which is the exclusive concessionary for Angolan diamond mining rights.

The Lucapa Board views the licence renewals as important steps in the Company's goal of unlocking the potential of the Lulo Diamond Concession, which has already produced world-class diamonds of up to 131.4 carats.
