#### **SECTION 708A NOTICE**

Lucapa Diamond Company Limited (**ASX: LOM**) ("Lucapa" or "the Company") advises that the Company has allotted 2,291,738 fully paid ordinary shares ("Shares") following the exercise of vested Performance Rights pursuant to the Company's Performance Rights Plan.

The Company also wishes to advise that 283,252 Performance Rights have lapsed.
